(4) **ECTS grading scale:**

ECTS Grade	% of successful students normally achieving the grade	Definition
A	10	outstanding performance without errors
B	25	above the average standard but with minor errors
C	30	generally sound work with some errors
D	25	fair but with significant shortcomings
E	10	performance meets the minimum criteria
FX	-	FAIL - some more work required before the credit can be awarded.
F	-	FAIL - considerable further work is required, the attendance rate was not sufficient to make the evaluation of knowledge and achievements.

Using words like “excellent” or “good” is no longer recommended as they do not fit with the percentage-based ranking of the ECTS Grade Transfer Scale.

(5) **ECTS credits:**

1 full academic year = 60 credits

1 semester = 30 credits

1 term/trimester = 20 credits
