

STEP 3: Letter of Acceptance




Please fill in the Application Form online

Fill in the online application carefully. Remember to use your name as it appears on your Passport/ID Card. After you have filled in the form, please click the "send application" button at the bottom of the page. There is NO need at this stage to send a paper copy of the application.

You can also apply for student accommodation using the same online application. There is no need to fill in any additional applications for accommodation.

After you have filled in the online application, you will receive an e-mail message that we've got your application.

Wait for your Letter of Acceptance, get more info on travel possibilities, medical insurance and visarequirements.


After processing of your application documents, you will receive an official Letter of Acceptance provided by an Erasmus + Coordinator. In addition to the Letter of Acceptance, you will receive all other relevant information concerning your studies at the Kielce University Technology including detailed information on your chosen courses.

Carefully choose your health insurance. Each student is responsible for purchasing health insurance for the entire time of the stay in Poland.

If you are not from the EU/EEA it is highly recommended to get a private health insurance that covers the most essential medical care in Poland.


